

Zumbro Community Church was established in 1990 by a small group of about 25 local Christians. Their first meeting was held in the home of John and Donna Adams. Further meetings and worship services were held at Woodland Camp and the former residence of Robert Mohler.

At these meetings, bylaws were written and officers (Elders) were selected to oversee the business needs and future direction of the church. Village Missions had agreed to help the church by supply us a pastor (Pastor Wendell Mohler). The first officers (Elders) were: Dave Mohler, Chairman; Mike Daniels, Secretary; John Adams, Treasurer.

Land was needed and sought to build a church building and parsonage. There seemed to be no suitable land for sale at the time, but through much prayer and persistence, Donna Adams made a suggestion to ask about a certain parcel of land along South County Road 7. The land was eventually purchased and a parsonage was built that same year. The church met in the basement until 2003 when they moved into the multi-purpose church building that had been being built since 2000.

Wendell Mohler (Village Missions) was pastor of the church for the first three years, followed by Tim Gray (Village Missions) for another three years. Since that time, about 1996, Dave Mohler has served as Pastor.

By 2000 the mortgage was paid off and the Lord had blessed us with enough money to start building a church building. Everyone agreed that a multiple use type of building would best minister to and serve the community's needs.
